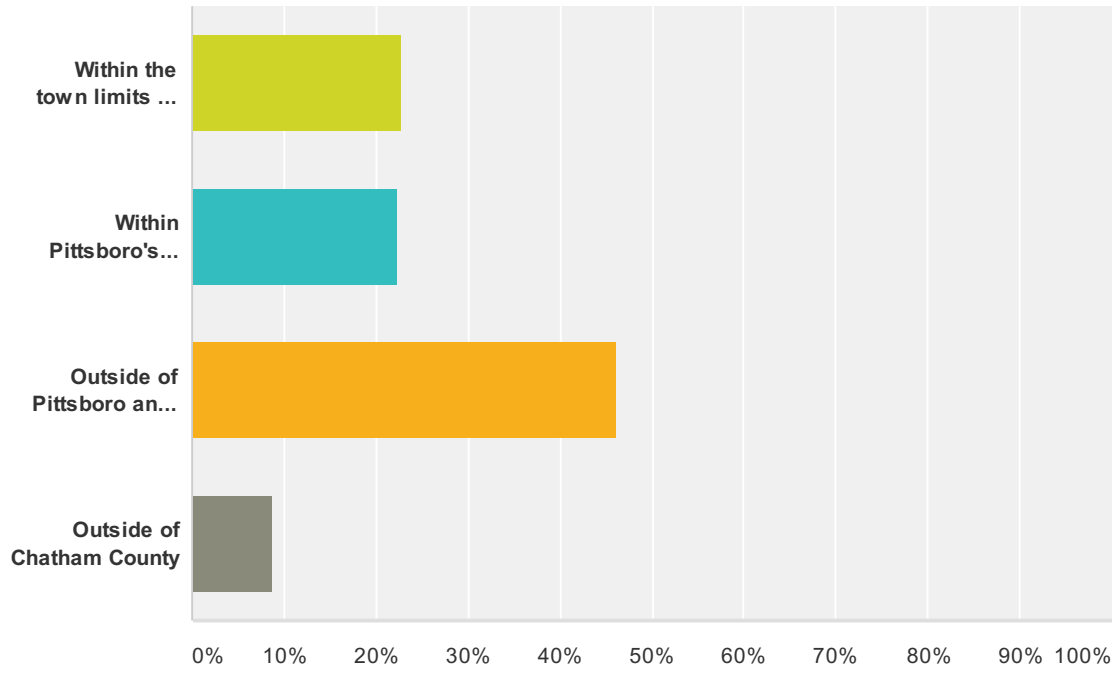


### Q1 Where do you reside?

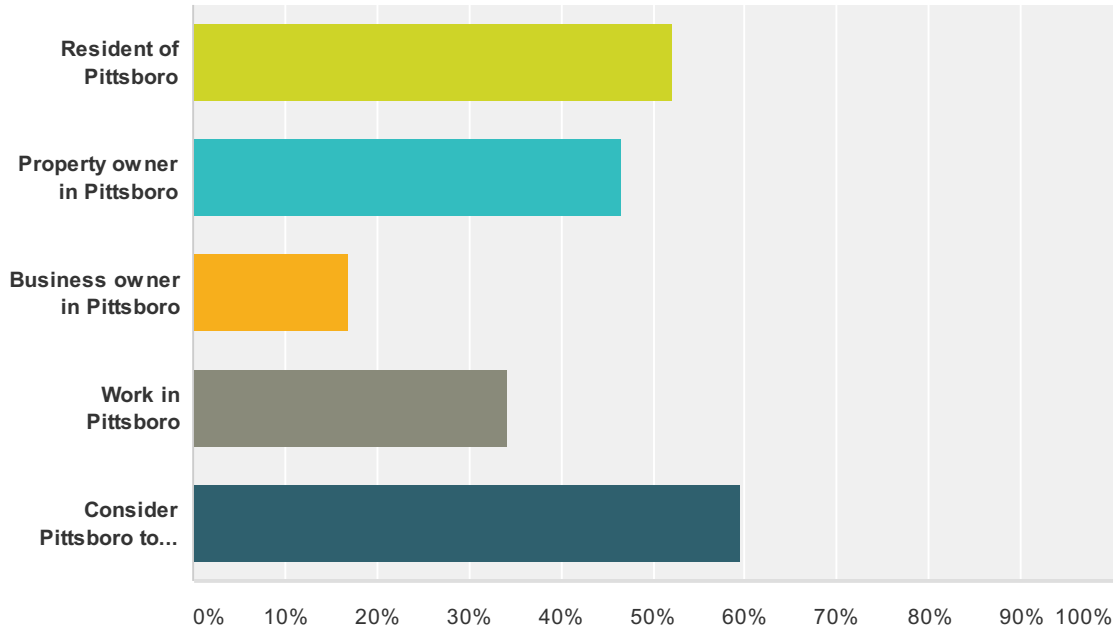

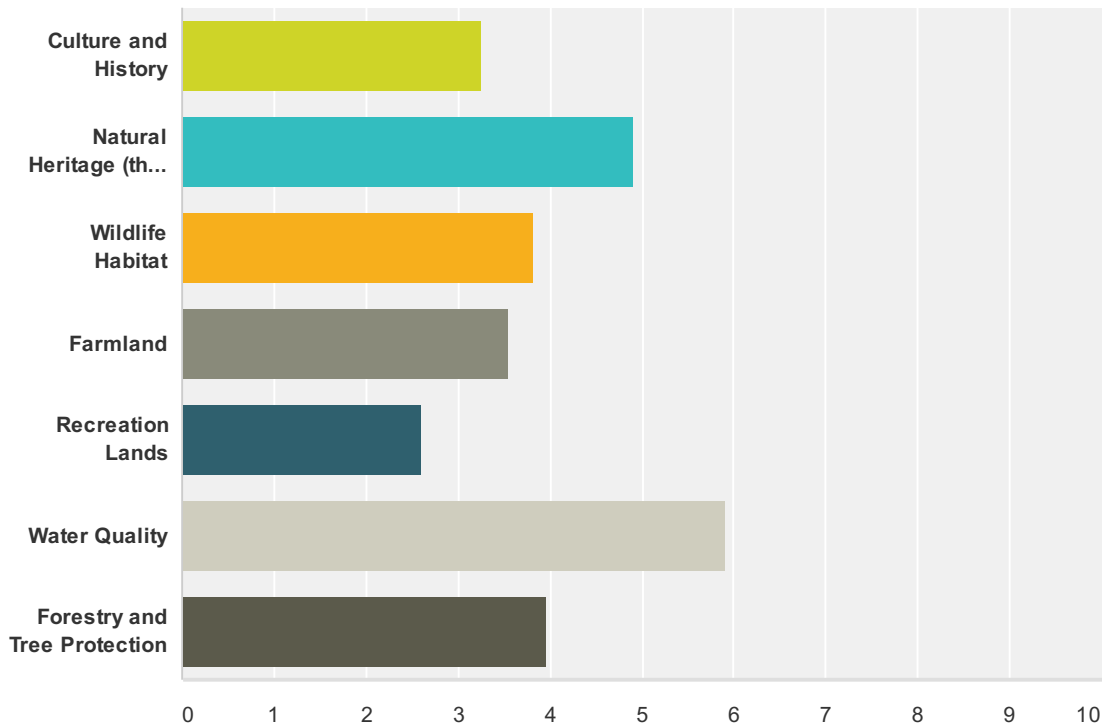

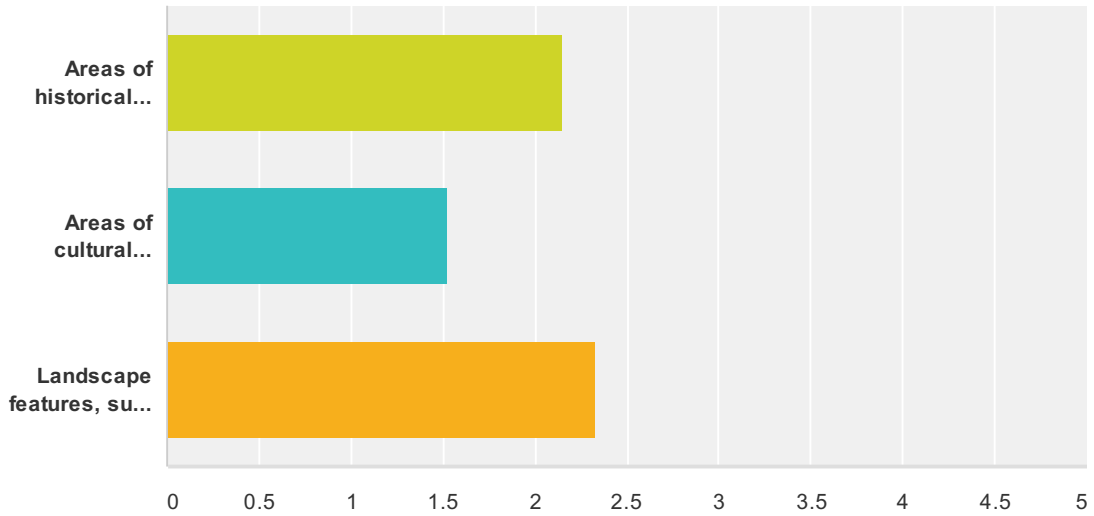

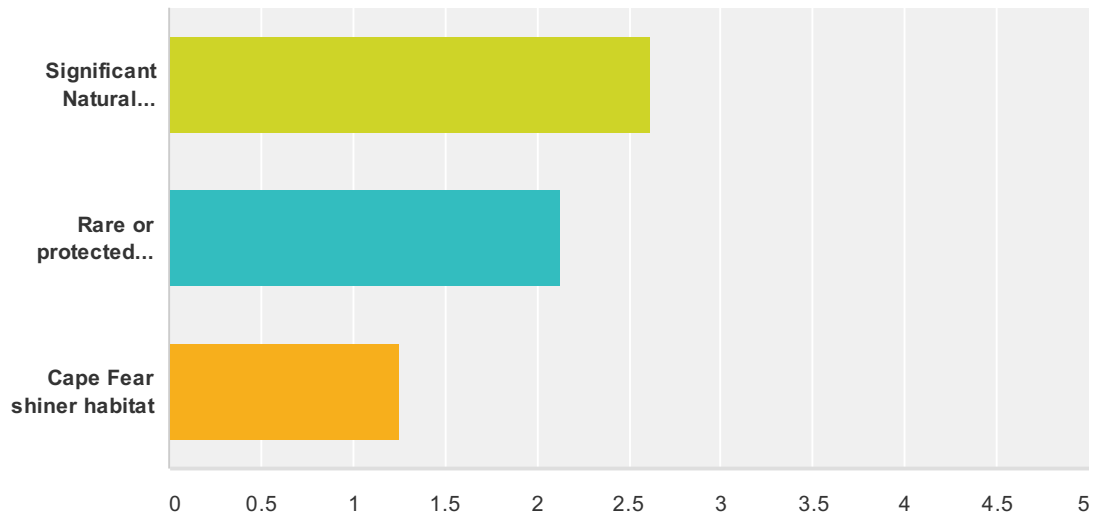

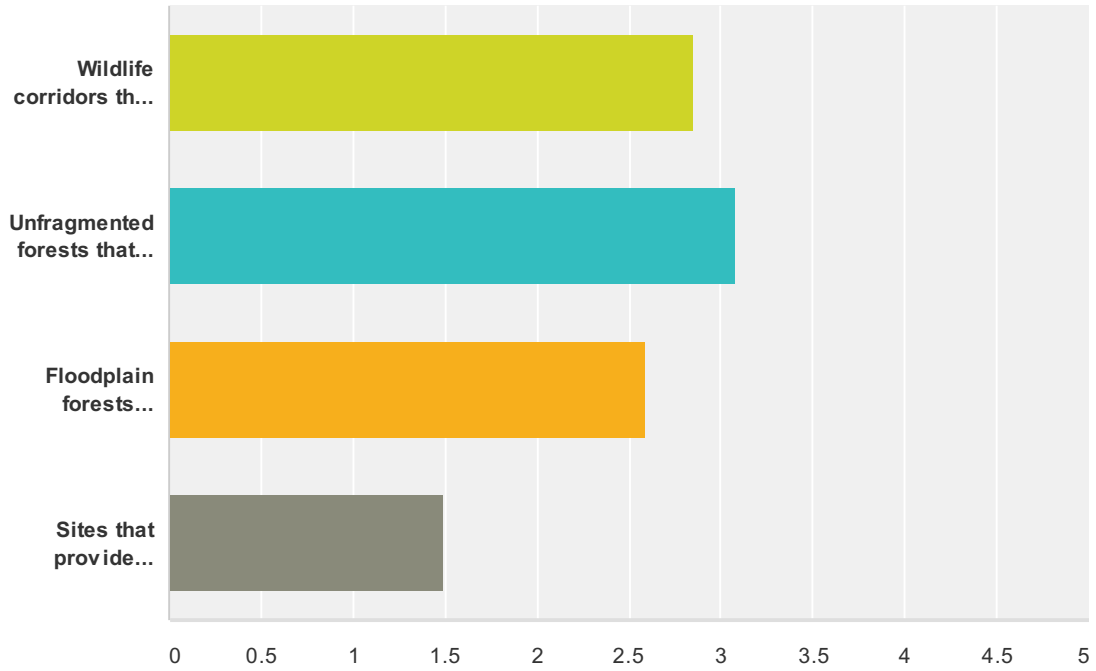

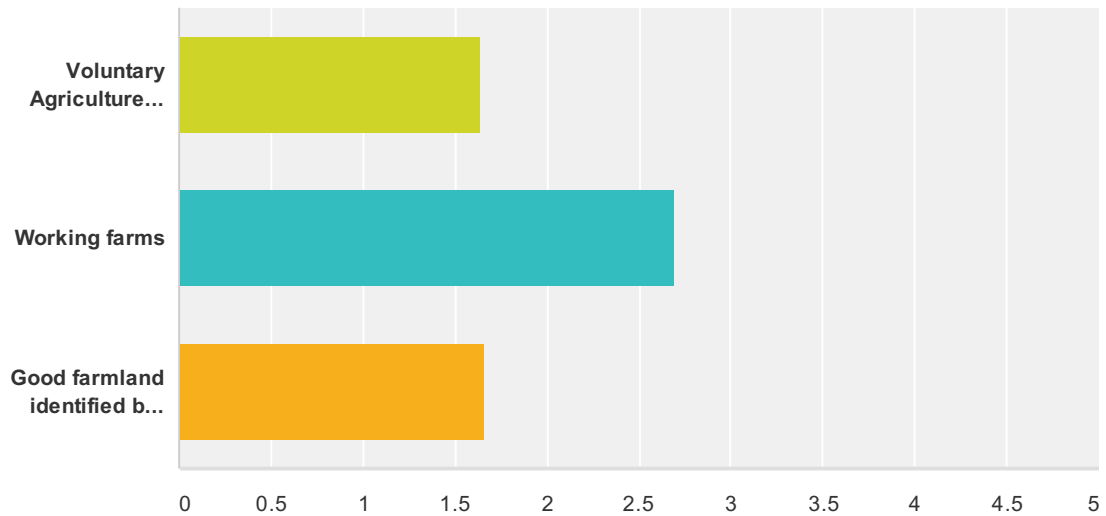

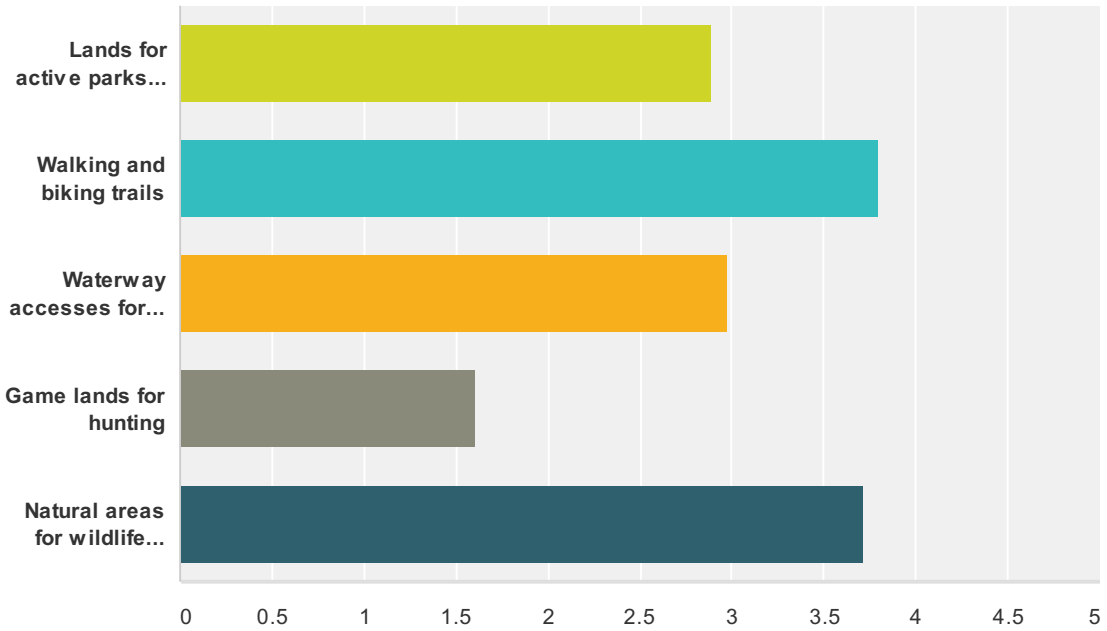

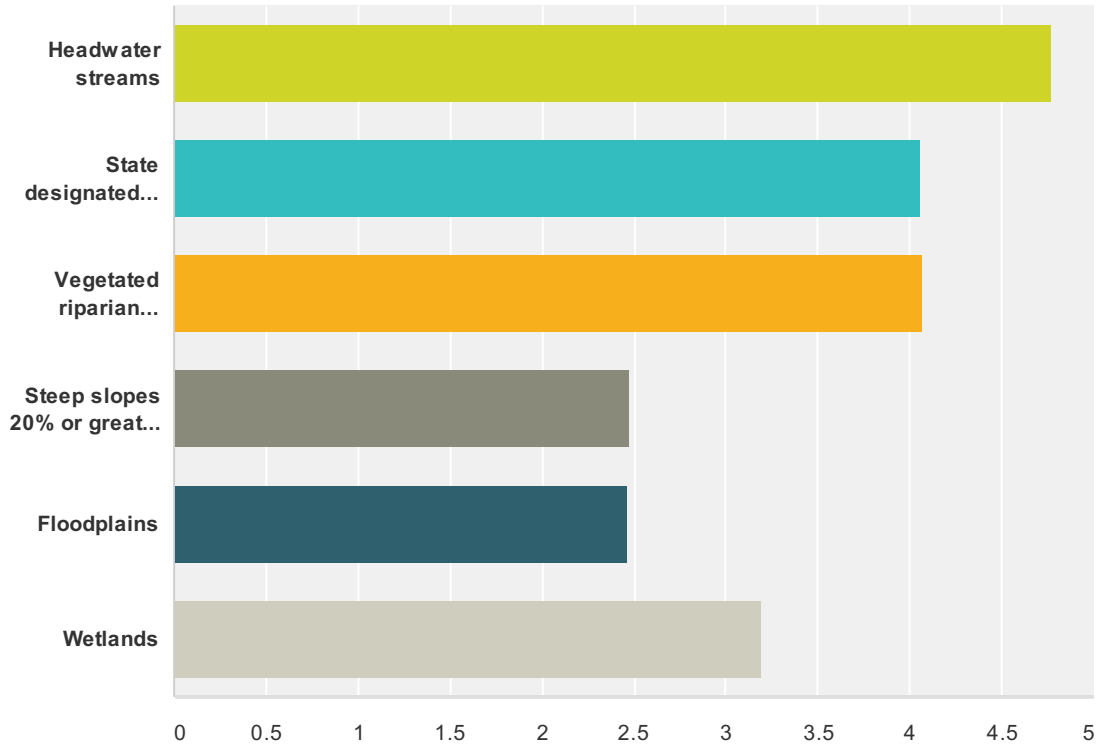

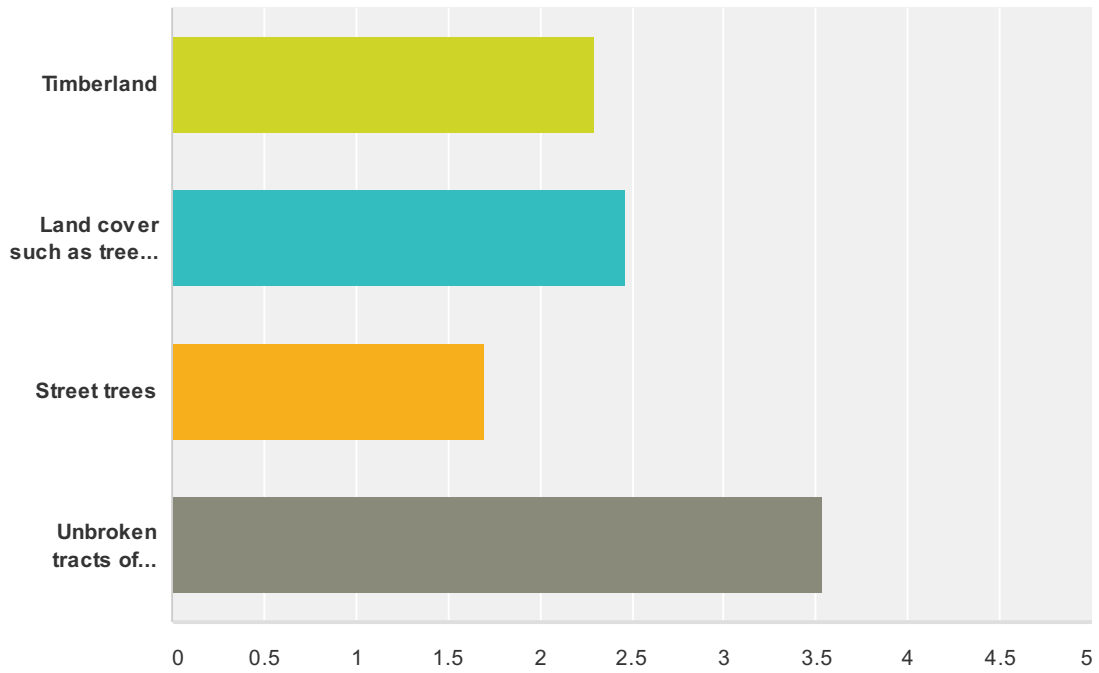
